Delivering hope to the needy

The Abaar Orphanage Bortown South Sudan Inc was set up in 2012 as an incorporated charitable institution and is registered with Consumer Affairs Victoria (Reg No A0058028V); ABN 84 932 954 309.

Our partner in Bor Town is the Abaar Orphanage Bor Town Foundation, (AOF) which was incorporated and registered as a non-profit organisation in South Sudan in December 2012

Delivering hope to the needy

Our focus is to:

- ✚ build a school to educate orphaned boys and girls (open to other needy local students)
- ✚ pay for school fees, uniforms and school essentials for orphaned children
- ✚ provide food, water and secure accommodation

Since 2012 we have raised over \$55,000, which has been used to:

- ✚ buy land in Bor Town as a site for our school and orphanage dormitories
- ✚ fence the land
- ✚ build two classrooms and a toilet block, built by local workers using local materials
- ✚ pay school fees and buy uniforms for 67 children
- ✚ buy personal solar lights

The money was raised by appeals to the Sudanese community in Australia, by selling hand-made goods at street stalls in Melbourne, and from generous donations from supporters, including many people at St Peter's Anglican Church, Box Hill, Victoria.

Our administrative costs are less than 3% of our budget.



Classroom and toilet block nearing completion

We are now appealing for donations so that we can:

- ✚ complete the current classrooms and toilet block (plastering and painting)
- ✚ build more classrooms – we need 8 in total
- ✚ dig a well to provide water to the school
- ✚ build 2 dormitories
- ✚ provide furniture
- ✚ landscaping
- ✚ continue to pay tuition fees and buy uniforms and school essentials

It costs

- ✚ about \$7,000 (AUD) to build a classroom
- ✚ \$30 in school fees (primary) and \$60 (secondary) for one year
