### FAQ

The Vicar alone can work in the church office but only if he or she lives directly onsite. Mowing lawns and gardening is not allowed. At funerals, the limit of ten mourners includes those giving eulogies, leading prayers, acting as pall bearers, etc, other than clergy or funeral director staff.

A group of five people broadcasting a service must stay the same each time. A church can have multiple groups of five for different days or services, or for alternate weeks, however there can be no overlap of clergy, technical people, musicians or others between these groups. Nobody else should be on the premises when a group is broadcasting a service.
